1. Was Developed _____ The Game Began

Genesis 50:20 (NIV) *"You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives."*

Exodus 3:16-17 (NIV) *"Go, assemble the elders of Israel and say to them, 'The LORD, the God of your fathers--the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob-- appeared to me and said: I have watched over you and have seen what has been done to you in Egypt. ¹⁷ And I have promised to bring you up out of your misery in Egypt into... a land flowing with milk and honey.'"*

Exodus 14:19-20 (NIV) *"Then the angel of God, who had been traveling in front of Israel's army, withdrew and went behind them. The pillar of cloud also moved from in front and stood behind them, ²⁰ coming between the armies of Egypt and Israel. Throughout the night the cloud brought darkness to the one side and light to the other side; so neither went near the other all night long."*

Exodus 14:3 (NIV) *"Pharaoh will think, 'The Israelites are wandering around the land in confusion, hemmed in by the desert.'"*

Exodus 14:6-8 (NIV) *"So he had his chariot made ready and took his army with him. ⁷ He took six hundred of the best chariots, along with all the other chariots of Egypt, with officers over all of them. ⁸ The LORD hardened the heart of Pharaoh King of Egypt, so that he pursued the Israelites, who were marching out boldly."*

Exodus 14:15 (NIV) *“Then the LORD said to Moses, ‘Why are you crying out to Me? Tell the Israelites to **move on.**’ ”*

Exodus 14:21-22 (NIV) *“Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea, and **all that night the LORD drove the sea back** with a strong east wind and turned it into dry land. The **waters were divided,** ²² and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a **wall of water on their right and on their left.**”*

Exodus 14:28 (NIV) *“The **water flowed back and covered the chariots and horsemen--the entire army of Pharaoh that had followed the Israelites into the sea. Not one of them survived.**”*

Exodus 14:4b (NIV) *“But **I will gain glory for Myself through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the LORD.**”*

- _____ God’s Perspective

Exodus 14:12-13 (NIV) *“**Didn’t we say to you in Egypt, ‘Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians?’ It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!**” ¹³ Moses answered the people, ‘Do not be afraid. Stand firm and **you will see the deliverance the LORD will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again.**”*

Exodus 14:14 (NIV) *“**The LORD will fight for you; you need only to be still.**”*

Exodus 14:31 (NIV) *“When the **Israelites saw the great power the LORD displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the LORD and put their trust in Him and in Moses His servant.**”*

Proverbs 3:5-7 (MSG) *“**Trust God from the bottom of your heart; don’t try to figure out everything on your own.** ⁶ Listen for God’s voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; **He’s the one who will keep you on track.** ⁷ Don’t assume that you know it all. **Run to God! Run from evil!**”*
